JOINING INSTRUCTION FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2019/2020

Blue Pharma College of Health is a private college fully registered by NACTE with REG. NO. REG/HAS/187.

1. THE COLLEGE OFFERS THE FOLLOWING PROGRAMS:

- (i) **Basic Technician certificate in pharmaceutical sciences (NTA LEVEL 4)**
- (ii) **Technician certificate in pharmaceutical sciences (NTA LEVEL 5)**

2. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL PROGRAMMES

On reporting day at Blue Pharma College of Health, report at the Admission office with the followings

- (i) Admission letter from Blue Pharma College of Health
- (ii) Original certificates of academic qualification (O-LEVEL/ A-LEVEL) or equivalent.
- (iii) Original birth certificate and/or affidavit.
- (iv) The original bank pay-in-slip for the payment of fees and other charges.
- (v) Duly filled Medical Examination form.
- (vi) One white Ream paper.

Warning: It is criminal offence to submit false Information/Certificates/Documents. Appropriate legal action will be taken in case of committing that offence

3. BASIC REQUIREMENTS FOR THE COURSE

NOTE: All students Uniforms are available at the college for the cost that is indicated in your specific course. You are required to pay and obtain your uniforms at the College and not otherwise. This is for uniformity, standards and descent uniforms as required by the College. Total cost of student uniform is **TSHS 130,000/=** which will cover, Two pairs of uniforms and one clinical coat.

Student should buy him/herself, Black Shoes, white socks and White headscarf (ushungi) for Muslim girl students.

Open shoes/sandals and canvas shoes for casual stay. All other outfits after classes MUST be of good manner.

5. REQUIREMENTS FOR PAYMENTS OF SCHOOL FEES AND OTHER CHARGES

- Tuition fees should be paid in full at the beginning of each academic year or in two equal installments at the beginning of each semester.
- Fees once paid will not be refunded if a student withdraws or leaves the College without permission from the Principal or is disqualified in examination or dismissed for indiscipline.
- However, fifty per cent (50%) of fees may be refunded, if a student notifies the Principal to withdraw from the college within the first four weeks from the beginning of the academic year.
- Payment by cheque, International Money Orders (IMO) etc is accepted prior to clearance by the bank.
- Payment by M-Pesa, TigoPesa, and Airtel Money is **STRICTLY NOT ACCEPTED**

NOTE: All fees should be paid to the college account and not otherwise, the moment you arrival to the college submit original pay in slip.

NOTE: For Hostel students are required to depend themselves on meals allowance, otherwise should pay to the college 1,500,000/= per year for meal allowance.

Note that:

1. Meals costs are optional to a student in need with the service (day students). Accommodation is strongly recommended for student's wellbeing.
2. Some students use fees for other purposes. Therefore, sponsors/ guardians/ parents are advised to pay fees directly to College Bank Accounts.
3. Students who possess national health insurance fund (NHIF) cards have to bring their cards, and are encouraged to use them. Those who are not members of NHIF, have to pay every year in order to get the cards. The bank pay –in – slip should be submitted to the office of accountant/cashier.
4. Student should come with complete uniform fee as indicated above.
